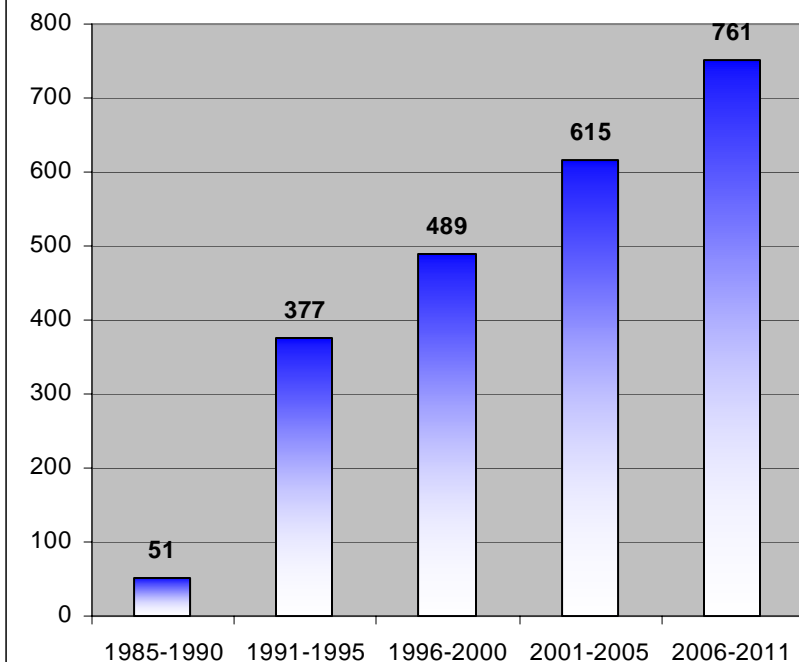
Our program's culture is shaped by board governance. Just as your agency operations are shaped by the interaction between a governing board and staff, so is ours. We "get it"; we know what life is like

Since 1985**

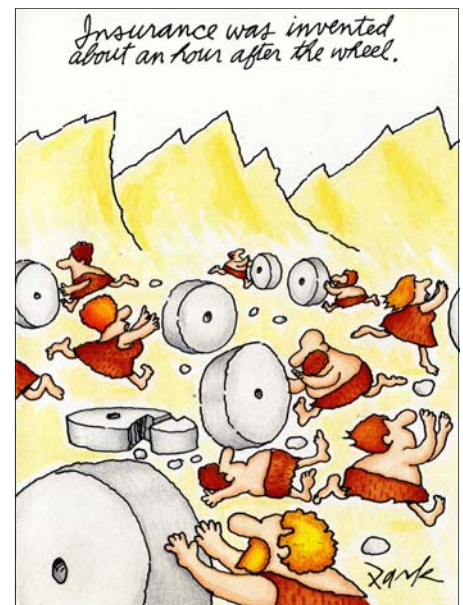
